Dear Sir:

We have awarded contracts to 4 companies for the street lights (a trencher/excavator; an electrical contractor, the supplier and Ohio Edison (for the final connections). The trencher excavator will begin trenching for the electric services for the lights beginning next week; lights should be installed within 30 to 45 days.

We have met and spoken with the developer about the other items, as recently as last week. They have promised to take action soon, blame delays on the weather, etc. We will stay on top of these issues.

As far as the mosquitoes, the City does not spray for mosquitoes, we will place 'dunks' in areas of standing water. These dunks are designed to kill the larvae before hatching. By copy of this email to our City Service Director (Nino Piccoli) I have passed on your request.

Please feel free to stay in touch, I will try to keep you informed of further developments. Thanks for your patience.
